DISTRICT 26 AA VOLLEYBALL RULES FOR 2004-2005 and 2005-2006 WILL BE AS FOLLOWS:

1. ADMISSION CHARGES TO DISTRICT 26AA GAMES

2. OFFICIALS:

There will be two certified neutral officials for the varsity games. If two certified neutral officials cannot be secured, then one certified neutral official, with another official approved by the visiting team, will be sufficient. The opposing coach should be notified regarding the officials at least seven days before the game, when possible.

3. DISTRICT PLAY: DOUBLE ROUND ROBIN

High school teams will play each other twice. The home team must notify the District Chairman if a game is changed. Schools will exchange schedules prior to the start of the season.

4. Rally Scoring

Follow Rally Scoring Format as provided by UIL. Sub-varsity teams will play 2 out of 3 to 25 (cap at 30), with the third game being played to 25 (cap at 30).

5. MANAGERS MAY KEEP THE SCOREBOOK AND OPERATE SCOREBOARDS.

6. GAME TIMES:

On Tuesdays, Freshman, Junior Varsity, and Varsity teams will play at the same site, beginning at 5:00 p.m.; on Fridays, Varsity games will be played at 4:30 p.m. and by mutual agreement of the two schools involved, Junior Varsity games following and being played by time (8 minutes).

7. TYPE OF BALL:

UIL approved volleyball.

8. DISTRICT GAME RESULTS:

The **HOME TEAM** will fax or email the game results to the Executive Secretary, Pete Kucera, **IMMEDIATELY** after each game by noon the next day. The Boling ISD fax number is 979-657-3265 and email is pkucera@bolingisd.net

9. ALL DISTRICT TEAM:

The coach of the district winner will call a meeting of varsity volleyball coaches during the first week after completion of the district competition to select players for the All-District Team. Results are not to be released until all three-district teams have been eliminated or have completed all play-off games. The meeting time will be after regular school hours in the evening.

10. DETERMINING THE DISTRICT WINNER AND RUNNER-UP:

- A. The team with the highest won-lost percentage shall be the district champion. The team with the second highest won-lost percentage shall be the district runner-up. In case of a tie for second place, the runner-up team will be determined in the same manner as the first place team.
- B. In the event that two teams tie, both teams will be declared co-champions. If one team has defeated the other in both district games, that team will be named the district champion with the other team as district runner-up. If the teams split in district games, there shall be a one-match play-off to be held on a neutral court.
- C. If three or more teams are tied, a tournament will be held at a site chosen by the teams involved. Teams will draw for positions. The team that wins the tournament will be declared champion.

If "A" or "B" is declared champion, then the loser between "A" and "B" will play "C" to determine runner-up in the district. If "C" wins tournament, the loser to team "C" will be declared runner-up.
