Please mail it by March 1, 2007. **A reminder that a UIL rule requires the director to present a script to the contest manager before the rehearsal is started along with proof of royalty payment, etc. This script shall represent exactly what is being performed. The script must be an original from the publisher (no copies made by a copy machine are allowed due to copyright) unless it is public domain.**
- I. **Entry Deadline:** The entry deadline is March 19, 2008. Please remember to entry your students on the UIL online entry system along with the paper entry forms. Remember to send one copy to Luis Munoz, the State Drama Director.
- I. **Set and Strike:** Details will be given during rehearsals.
- J. **Lighting:** Details will be given during rehearsals. Contest Directors need lighting plot, etc. at least two weeks before the contest.
- K. **Sound:** Your crew must operate any sound your show requires. Bring your own sound equipment.
